Varietal: Malbec (100%)

Terroir: Argentine is currently the world's largest producer of Malbec. This

variety was introduced by the French agronomist Michel Pouget in 1868. Made in the provinces of Lujan de Cuyo and Maipu, in a continental, semi desert climate, the wine is immediately engaging.

Wine-Making: Long fermentation with controlled temperatures.

Tasting:

The nose has lovely red fruit aromas and the wine displays a subtle

balance between roundness and fruitiness on the palate. There is plenty of volume and a smooth aftertaste. Fruity, elegant, smooth, and

complex, this Argentinian Antisto is a true pleasure.
